Nancy Wake was a British Special Operations agent during WW2. She was a master of espionage and one of the most decorated servicewomen of the British Intelligence Service. Using her intelligence and skill, she was able to evade capture for the whole of her military career. During this unit, your team of spies will train to the highest level, remain undetected and complete a range of missions, concluding when they are able to transport allied soldiers across the French border into Spain.
