Fact Bank

Numbers are joined up by hyphens i.e. *vingt-deux* (22), *trente-quatre* (34)

There is one difference:
for 21, 31, 41, and 51, the word *et* (and) is required between the tens word and *un*, without hyphens.

21 = *vingt et un*

31 = *trente et un*

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
